



## II. PROJECT FLOW

After the methodology document is developed based on the repository created and the lesson plans are prepared on water, sun, air, soil, and wind with different forms arts, ARTinED piloting start. It will take place mainly at two phases.

- The first phase will be implemented in 8 European schools at two levels.
  - The first level deals with the creation of the artistic production on water as the major subject and soil as a minor subject. Each responsible partner will pilot its art form; i.e. Fondazione Nazionale Carlo Collodi, Collodi from Italy Literature and creative writing, The Mosaic Art and Sound from the UK Music and drama, Viksjöforsbaletten, Viksjöfors from Sweden Dance, Liceul de Artă Dinu Lipatti from Romania Visual Arts, and Confederación Española de Centros de Enseñanza, Madrid from Spain poetry. Children will create and deliver art performances in music, dance, painting, visual arts, drama, poems, and creative writing, and will learn about water and soil as natural resources. The piloting tasks are designed for classroom collaborative work; taking tasks into the wider local community; and sharing the tasks with other piloting schools across Europe. This first level will take 18 hours in each piloting country.
  - The second level foresees an exchange among the schools of their artistic production. Children will upload parts of their artistic productions in the virtual community space (ARTinED wiki) to share with pupils in other countries. For instance, children in Romania will use songs created by their peer students in Italy, and these may use poems and drawings created in a school in Spain or dance choreography from Sweden. Then each school will rehearse a more complete performance and this will be presented to other children, teachers and families. Local professional artists will be invited by the partners to work with children in preparing the performance. The audience will be informed on the ARTinED learning activities which were to teach curriculum subjects through arts, and the European dimension of the project. In fact, the children's ARTinED activities will expand to a wider European dimension as schools across Europe will take part by uploading their own artistic materials on the ARTinED wiki space. This level will last 8 hours, and the final performance duration is 45 minutes.
- The second phase is related to the piloting the ARTinED methodology in 20 schools with 400
- Students; once the methodology document is uploaded on the project website, some more schools (at least 12, 12+8) will be invited to pilot some of the ARTinED activities and these activities will be shared on the ARTinED wiki.



The purpose of the ARTinED wiki (<http://artined-eu.wikispaces.com/>) which is provided in 6 languages (English, Spanish, Italian, Swedish, Turkish and Romanian) is to provide a space for schools and teachers to add their classroom productions created for the project. You will need to register and be approved before adding your content. You can embed a YouTube video images and information about your use of ARTinED. Each participating school will have their own Wiki page where they can add some brief Information about your school, videos of your work with the project (they should be less than 5 minutes each) ,information about your use of the Project. Every school page will also have a discussion forum, so other schools and students can post comments.
